

Scandinavian Tourism & 2UE Holiday Competition

Terms and Conditions.

1. Information on how to enter and prizes form part of these conditions.
2. The Promoter is Radio 2UE 170 Pacific Hwy, Greenwich 2065 NSW. Ph: 02 9930 9954.
3. The promotion period begins on Monday 29th June at 5.30am and ends by 6pm on Friday 3rd July, 2009
4. Entry is open to Australian residents only and entry is deemed as acknowledgement and acceptance of Conditions of Entry.
5. Fairfax Radio employees, their immediate families and any agencies associated with this promotion including Scandinavian Tourism, Scandinavian Airlines, MyPlanet, Great Dane Furniture and Pandora are excluded from entry.
6. The major prize consists of a trip to Scandinavia including; two (2) return economy class tickets to Scandinavia (Copenhagen; ground transport between the three capitals and airport transfers; two (2) nights accommodation for two (2) persons twin share in each capital; Copenhagen, Oslo and Stockholm, including breakfast.
7. The major prize is valued at \$15,000 AUD including GST
8. The minor prizes are valued at between \$100 and \$140 each
9. Total value of prize pool is \$16,040 AUD.
10. The major prize draw will be conducted on 3/7/09 between 12:00pm and 12:30pm by an independent party.
11. There will be one (1) major prize awarded.
12. The prizes cannot be transferred or redeemed for cash.
13. The winner will be notified of their win in writing and by a live announcement on 2UE between 3:00pm and 6:00pm on Friday 3rd July 2009.
14. No discussion will be entered into regarding the selection of any winning entrants.
15. By accepting the prize, winners agree that 2UE; Fairfax Radio Network and Scandinavian Tourism can use their name, location, photo (taken in conjunction with the prize) and audio of winning for publicity purposes.
16. If a prize winner is under the age of 18 years, the prize will be awarded to their parent or legal guardian. Minors may use the prize, but they must be accompanied by a person over 18 years and have consent from their parent or legal guardian (which the Promoter may request in writing).
17. If a prize winner's guest is under the age of 18 years, they must have consent from their parent or legal guardian (which the Promoter may request in writing) to take the Prize.
18. A parental or guardian consent referred to in these terms must:(a) consent to the matters referred to in these terms and conditions; and (b) include the words "in consideration of 2UE; Fairfax Radio Network and Scandinavian Tourist Board agreeing to admit the entrant into this Promotion, [name of Parent or Guardian] agrees to be bound by the terms of entry into the Promotion".

19. The Prize winner and their guest may be required to sign a release and indemnity form in favour of the Promoter and return the document to the Promoter prior to taking their prize.
20. Travel must be taken between July 15, 2009 and September 30, 2010. The tickets must be completed, booked and issued by 21 December, 2009. Cancellations less than 30 days prior to departure will attract a cancellation fee. Flight tickets are subject to availability. The ground arrangements are subject to MyPlanet/MyBentours Booking Terms & Conditions (see separate document) and the Site's "Terms of Use" and "Privacy & Security Policy". The prize automatically expires if travel is not booked/departed by the above due dates.
21. The Prize winner (and their guest) must hold a valid passport in order to take the Prize and must obtain any necessary visas to travel at their own expense.
22. Flights must leave from and return to Sydney, Australia. It is the responsibility of the winner to make their own way to the departure port, at their own cost
23. Prize flights and flight times are subject to availability and are at the discretion of the Promoter.
24. The airline and hotel in the travel component of the Prize are at the discretion of the Promoter.
25. All other costs associated with the Prize are the responsibility of the winner (including but not limited to passports, visas, spending money, meals, government imposed departure taxes, airport security charges and insurance, other than as mentioned).
26. Travel insurance is the responsibility of the winner. It is strongly recommended that the winner obtains a travel insurance policy before departure. Travel insurance is compulsory for some services managed by MyPlanet.
27. The Scandinavian Tourist Board will be responsible for fuel surcharges relating to the flight component of the Prize between Sydney and Copenhagen..
28. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for any tax liabilities other than mentioned that may arise from winning a prize and any such tax liability must be paid by the winner.
29. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for any tax liability incurred as a result of an entrant participating in the Promotion. Entrants should obtain independent tax and financial advice.
